



THIRD CALL FOR PROJECTS - February 2019

1. National Arts Fund

The National Arts Fund has been set up under the *aegis* of the Ministry of Arts and Culture to contribute in the funding of creative arts projects/ programmes with a view to empowering artists, arts practitioners and arts organisations in the different fields of arts and culture.

2. Arts Grant Schemes

In line with its aims and objectives, the National Arts Fund has designed four Arts Grant Schemes, namely, **(i) Emerging Talents Grant Scheme; (ii) Production Grant Scheme; (iii) Capacity Building Grant Scheme; and (iv) Research Grant Scheme.**

3. Calls for Projects

The National Arts Fund is launching its **third** call for projects under the Emerging Talents Grant, Production Grant and Research Grant Schemes.

Applications under the Capacity Building Grant Scheme can be submitted throughout the year.

Applications received after the deadline, not made in the appropriate form and incomplete applications will **not** be considered.

6. Application forms under the Capacity Building Grant Scheme along with all relevant documents should be submitted at least four weeks before the start of the project.
