



## **EIGHTH CALL FOR PROJECTS – OCTOBER 2023**

### **1. National Arts Fund**

The National Arts Fund has been established under the Finance and Audit (National Arts Fund) Regulations 2017, to contribute to the financing of creative arts projects/ programmes with a view to empowering artists, arts practitioners and arts organisations in the different fields of arts and culture.

### **2. Arts Grant Schemes**

In line with its aims and objectives, the National Arts Fund has designed five Arts Grant Schemes, namely, (i) **Emerging Talents Grant Scheme**; (ii) **Production Grant Scheme**; (iii) **Capacity Building Grant Scheme**; (iv) **Research Grant Scheme** and (v) **Digital Creative Art Grant**

### **3. Call for Projects**

The National Arts Fund is launching its **eighth** call for projects under the Emerging Talents Grant, Production Grant, Research Grant and Digital Creative Art Grant Schemes.

Applications under the Capacity Building Grant Scheme can be submitted throughout the year.

Application forms for the Emerging Talent Grant, Production Grant, Research Grant and Digital Creative Art Grant Schemes, together with all relevant documents, should be submitted to the **National Arts Fund, Ministry of Arts and Cultural Heritage, 1<sup>st</sup> Floor, Renganaden Seeneevassen Building, Cnr Pope Hennessy and Maillard Streets, Port Louis** by **Monday, 30 October 2023 at 15 00 hrs** at latest. Applications received after the deadline, not made in the appropriate form and incomplete applications will **not** be considered.

6. Application forms under the Capacity Building Grant Scheme along with all relevant documents should be submitted at least four weeks before the start of the project.
